Maslin makes headway for Netball

Gundagai Shire Councillor, William Maslin, today said that Council is working hand in hand with Gundagai netball.

Cr Maslin called a meeting between Council and netball representatives at the end of July to discuss ways the Council and Gundagai Netball could progress with their dream of having public netball courts in Gundagai.

"The meeting was to get both parties on the same page after some confusion within the community about what was happening with the proposed courts," Cr Maslin said.

"We discussed the outcome of the federal grant (Council being unsuccessful) and what the next steps were. The meeting agreed that it was appropriate to have the old tennis court proposal re-costed and Council to initiate discussions with another organisation in town about the idea of having temporary courts in the short term to keep players in town.

"The matter was discussed at the August Council meeting and is fully supported by Councillors," Cr Maslin concluded.
