Councillor William Maslin said today, he is extremely pleased with the outcome of the Working Group meeting for the formation of a youth council.

"The group looked at the feasibility and viability of a youth council. While it was hard to determine in that setting, the group decided to hold an initial meeting of interested youth persons on Thursday 18th June at 6:00pm in the Council Chambers," Cr Maslin said.

"The first meeting is open to persons aged 12 to 25 with parents and caregivers most welcome to attend. This meeting will be used to measure the interest and if attendance is good, a constitution will be developed, election of office bearers, a naming and logo competition and discussion on a fundraising project will occur.

"The meeting will be advertised in the school's newsletters and in the Gundagai Independent. The most important thing is, that if you are a member of the community aged 12 to 25 and are interested in giving youth a voice, helping them and organising activities for them, then come and join in on Thursday," Cr Maslin concluded.
